NORTH CRAVEN WILLS AND INVENTORIES

The transcription of wills and inventories from copies held at a variety of regional Record Offices, The National Archives and the Borthwick Institute for Archives at York University is being undertaken by volunteers. A date of 1750 has been set to limit the extent of the work. The set for Giggleswick Ancient Parish has been completed. The Ancient Parish includes the modern parishes of Giggleswick, Langcliffe, Rathmell, Settle and Stainforth. The set for Ingleton has been completed and published in book form, i.e. 'Voices from the past, 1548 to 1700', and 'Inventories and Wills from the Parish of Ingleton 1700-1750' by Carol Howard and Sheila Gordon with members of Ingleborough Archaeology Group, in 2015 and 2016. The set for Clapham parish has been completed up to 1603. The set for Horton in Ribblesdale is complete to 1603 and progress is being made to extend the date range to 1700. The set from 1700 to 1750 has been completed by Sheila Gordon.
