The fees, payments & sums set out below apply
 where the person to be interred, or in respect of whom
 the right is granted is, or immediately before his
 death was an inhabitant or parishioner of the
 Parish of Horton-in-Ribblesdale, or, in the case of a
 still-born child, where the parents (or one of them)
 are, or at the time of interment were, such inhabitants
 or parishioners.

In all other cases the fees, payments & sums
 will be doubled, except that those set out in
 Parts 1 & 3 will not be doubled where the exclusive
 rights of burial in the grave in question, or the right
 of constructing the grave was acquired at the single

fee as set out in part 2. Fees are doubled after
 20 yrs absence from the parish.

Part 1 Interments

The fees indicated for the various heads of items
 1. 2. 3. (a) do not include the digging of a grave
 (B) apply only where the interment is made between the
 hours of 10 a.m. & 3 a.m. on Monday to Friday or
 between the hours of 10 a.m. & 3 a.m. on Saturday or on
 the certificate of a coroner or registered medical
 practitioner that immediate interment is necessary.

- (1) For the interment in respect of which an exclusive
 right of burial has not been granted:-
- (i) The body of a still born child, or a child whose age
 at the time of death did not exceed one month £1
 - (ii) The body of a child whose age at the time
 of death exceeded one month but did not exceed
 12 years. £3
 - (iii) The body of a person whose age at the time
 of death exceeded 12 years. £5
