To this court comes Adam Armytsted of Hunthwayte, tenant of the lord acknowledging an Indenture made between him and James Foster and Robert Crake concerning land at Hunthwayte called *All the Ynge ground*, with waters and other liberties and commodities, ... litle Calf close, old leis ... from 22 December last past for eight years, for which James and Robert gave 56s for their fine to the use of the lord.
