To all Persons to whom these Presents shall come We
Richard Clapham of Harzou Stephen
Knowles of Newby William Bradley of Giggleswick Henry
Waddington of Crow Nest and Thomas Carr of Stackhouse all
in the County of York Gentlemen Serd Greeting
Whereas by an Act of Parliament made in the thirty first
year of the Reign of his present Majesty King George the Second
intituled an Act for establishing and conforming Articles of
Agreement for dividing and inclosing two stinted pastures or
Commons called Settle Bankes High Scarr and Scaleber
within the Township of Settle in the County of York
it was (amongst other things) enacted that the said two stinted
pastures or commons should on or before the first day of May in
the year of our Lord 1759 be set out divided and allotted by us the
said Richard Clapham Stephen Knowles William Bradley
Henry Waddington and Thomas Carr Commissioners thereby
appointed and our Successors or any three or more of us or them
in the manner and subject to the Rules Orders and directions in
and by the said Act ordered directed established appointed and
prescribed And for the more just and regular division and
Distribution of the said two stinted pastures or commons so to be
divided and allotted as aforesaid and for the better ascertaining
the same It was thereby further enacted & declared that a Survey
should be made of the said two stinted pastures or commons so
intended to be inclosed as aforesaid some time before the first
day of August A. D. 1758 by such person or persons as should
be nominated and appointed for that purpose by us the said
Commissioners and our Successors or Survivors or any three or
more of us or them And that such Admeasurement and Survey
should be reduced into Writing and laid before the Commissioners
at all and every of their Meetings And that within Eight Months
after such Survey should be made and completed All the said two
stinted pastures or commons called Settle Bankes High Scarr
and Scaleber should be by us the said Commissioners and our
Successors or the Survivors or any three or more of us or them
set out ascertained divided and allotted unto and amongst all

To all Persons to whom these Presents shall come We

Whereas by an Act of Parliament made in the thirty first year of the Reign of his present Majesty King George the Second intituled An Act for establishing and conforming Articles of Agreement for dividing and inclosing two stinted pastures or Commons called Settle Banks High Scarr and Scaleber within the Township of Settle in the County of York it was (amongst other things) enacted that the said two stinted pastures or commons should on or before the first day of May in the year of our Lord 1759 be set out divided and allotted by us the said Richard Clapham Stephen Knowles William Bradley Henry Waddington and Thomas Carr Commissioners thereby appointed and our Successors or any three or more of us or them in the manner and subject to the Rules Orders and directions in and by the said Act ordered directed established appointed and prescribed And for the more just and regular division and Distribution of the said two stinted pastures or commons so to be divided and allotted as aforesaid and for the better ascertaining the same It was thereby further enacted & declared that a Survey should be made of the said two stinted pastures or commons so intended to be inclosed as aforesaid some time before the first day of August A. D. 1758 by such person or persons as should be nominated and appointed for that purpose by us the said Commissioners and our Successors or Survivors or any three or more of us or them And that such Admeasurement and Survey should be reduced into Writing and laid before the Commissioners at all and every of their Meetings And that within eight Months after such Survey should be made and completed All the said two stinted pastures or commons called Settle Banks High Scarr and Scaleber should be by us the said Commissioners and our Successors or the Survivors or any three or more of us or them set out ascertained divided and allotted unto and amongst all

every the Owners and Proprietors of Cattle gates and Sheep gates in and upon
the same according to the Number of Cattle gates and Sheep gates of each
person therein in such quantities shares and proportions as by us the said
Commissioners and our Successors or the Survivors or any three or more of
us or them should be adjudged and determined to be a full Recompense
Equivalent and Satisfaction for all the Cattle gates & Sheep gates and other
Interest that the several Owners proprietors and persons respectively then
had or could or might claim demand or be intitled to in or upon the sd
two stuted Pastures or Commons so intended to be inclosed as aforesaid
subject nevertheless to the Rules provisions and directions thereafter mented
expressed prescribed & contained Provided always that nothing in the
sd Act containd should extend or be construed to extend to empower us the
said Commissioners or any of us to give any undue preference to any of
the parties interested or concerned in the said intended Division and
inclosure But that in making all such Divisions and allotments we
should have a due Regard as well to the quality as the quantity of the
said two stuted pastures or commons so to be divided and allotted as aforesaid
and that the parcel and quantity of Land to be allotted to the several
Owners and Proprietors of the Cattle gates and Sheep gates as aforesaid
should be laid out and allotted to each of them respectively so that the
same might be contiguous and lie together or as near as conveniently
might be and in one entire plot or parcel if the same could conveniently
be done And it was thereby further enacted & declared that we
the sd Comms and our Successors or Survivors or any three or more of
us or them should or might ascertain set out and appoint all publick
and private ways or Roads and passages in and throughout the said
two stuted pastures or commons so to be enclosed as afo with the Sizes &
Breathes thereof so as all publick Roads to be made should be and contain
twelve yards broad at the least between the Ditches And that from the
time or times of making such new publick or private ways Roads or passages
it should not be lawful for any person on foot or on horseback or with
any Beast Coach Cart Waggon or other Carriage whatsoever to use any
Roads ways or passages either publick or private in over through^{or} upon the
said two stuted pastures or Commons so intended to be inclosed as afo
other than such new Roads or ways as should be ascertained laid out and
appointed as afo And it was thereby further enacted & declared that where

any parcel of Land so allotted as aforesaid should abutt or adjoin upon any Highway the Hedge Ditch Fence or Wall of the said Lot or Share so far as the same should abutt or adjoin upon any Highway shall be repaired & maintained at the sole costs and charges of the Person intitled to such Lot or portion for the time being for ever And also that all other fences to be made for inclosing separating and dividing the said two stinted pastures or Commons pursuant to the said Act should after the said Inclosures were made be repaired and maintained by such person and persons and in such manner as we the said Comms and our Successors or the Survivors or any three or more of us or them should in that behalf order direct and appoint pursuant to the Tenor true intent and meaning of the sd Act And such Award Order and Determination by us or our Successors and the Survivors or any three or more of us or them in that behalf should be binding and conclusive to the several parties interested in and intitled to such Share and allotment as aforesaid And whereas for preventing all differences and disputes relating to the sd Inclosures and Division It was thereby further enacted that immediately after the sd Comms should have completed & finished the Division partition and allotments of the said two stinted pastures or Commons pursuant to the purport and directions of the sd Act they should form and draw up and they were thereby authorized and directed to form and draw up An Award or Instrument in Writing which should express and contain the Number of Cattle gates and Sheep gates of each person in and upon the sd two stinted pastures or commons distinguishing how many thereof were freehold and how many thereof were held for Terms of years under the Countess Dowager of Burlington and by whom respectively And weh should also express and contain ^{the substance} in St. M^rs of Cleres Woods and piches contained in the sd two stinted pastures or commons and the Quantity of each and every part thereof assigned and allotted to the respive parties intitled to or interested in the same and a Description of the Situation Buttals and Boundaries of the same parcels and allotments respively distinguishing also the freehold from the Leasehold Shares so held for long Terms of years under the sd Countess Dowager of Burlington to the end that the sd Leasehold Shares might be held by the several and respive person & parts to whom the same should be allotted and their several and respive Executors admors and assigns for the Remainder of

the respective terms therein to come And shod also contain orders and directions for Hedging Ditching Walling and fencing the same and keeping and maintaining such Hedges Ditches Walls and fences in Repair and for making and laying out proper Ways bridges passages and watercourses in and through the same premises and supporting and Maintaining the same And also shod contain such other Orders regulations and determinations as shod be proper and necessary to be inserted therein conformable to the true intent purport and tenor of the sd Act, And it was thereby directed that the said Instrument shod be fairly ingrossed on parchment and signed by the sd Comms or their Successors or Survivors or any three or more of them and should be enrolled in the publick Register Office in Wakefield established by Parliament for the registry of Deeds Conveyances Wills and other Incumbrances affecting Lands tenements and heres in the Co. R. of the City of York to the end recourse might be had to the same by any person or persons interested in the sd Division and Inclosure And it was by the sd Act further enacted that the several Lands and Grounds so to be divided let out allotted and appointed to and for the several persons who by virtue thereof shod be intituled to the same shod be in full bare satisfaction and compensation for his her and their said several and respective Cattelgates and Sheep Gates wch before the passing of the sd Act were in and upon the sd two stinted pastures or commons thereby intended to be inclosed And that from and immediately after the making the sd Division and Allotment, and the Execution of the sd Award or Instrument of such Tenor & purport as aforementioned All the said Cattelgates and Sheeppgates belonging or claimed by all and every or any of the Owners and Proprietors thereof whether freehold or held for Terms of years within or upon the sd two stinted pastures or commons so intended to be inclosed as aforesaid should cease and be absolutely extinguished, Provided always & it was thereby further enacted that the Lands or Grounds in the sd two stinted pastures or commons which shod be allotted as aforesaid to any of the Proprietors in lieu of any Cattelgate or Cattelgates Sheeppgate or Sheeppgates belonging to such Proprietors respectively wch were freehold shod for ever after such Award so made be deemed to be freehold And should be held by and under the same Tenures Rents Customs and services as the freehold Cattelgate or Cattelgates Sheeppgate or Sheeppgates in lieu of which such Allotments shod

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be made were then held And that the 5th Sands & grounds in the 5th &
two stined pastures, or commons which should be allotted, as aforesaid
to any of the Proprietors in lieu of any Battlegate or Battlegates Sheepgate or
sheepgates belonging to such proprietors respectively which were held as aforesaid
for long years under the 5th Counts Dowager of Burlington should

deemed to be leasehold & should be held by & under the same Tenures rents

one or more of them were they empowered to administer) or by such other
evidence proof ways or means as to them shod seem requisite & expedient

unto them that the s^d W. Overend had a fur^r right upon the s^d Sealer for 3/4 ancient

further determined & declared that it appeared unto them that the s^d Henry

whof they did they award that he was intitled to 8 beastgates upon the s^d Sealeber
