[66] **Settle Pleas 14 October 32 Eliz**

John Lupton of Settle complains against John Altham and John Kidd of Settle because they entered a parcel of meadow at Reddinge in Settle which George Somerscale and others demised to the complainant.

Christopher Armitsted of Settle complains against John Kinge of the same because he took and carried away his dung and ash being at Settle.

Miles Heyton of Settle complains against Richard Bradley of the same because he mowed his grass growing at Nadbreck in Settle and converted it to his own use for the space of three years.

William Breanand of Settle complains against Adam Pailey re debt of 20d for manual labour.

Nicholas Benson of Giggleswick complains against Christopher Mawdisley late of Preston because the defendant, in consideration of 4d paid out of a greater sum at Giggleswick, promised him he labour and come to the aforesaid Nicholas at Beverley on a certain day, and would carry two packs of merchandise from Beverley within a certain time. He did not do so.

William Lupton of Feror complains against Robert Lupton of the same in a plea of breach of agreement concerning the occupation of the moiety of a messuage in Feror.

[67] William Cookeson complains against Leonard Chapman re trespass upon the case.

John Kinge of Settle complains against Christopher Armisted of the same because he unjustly occupied the complainant's soil and garden at Settle.
