[59] Brian Cookeson of Settle enclosed and occupied the Lords' waste
at

Camock End by the side of the waters of Ribble, in one place
100 rods in
length and two rods in width, and in another place there 40 rods
in
length and six rods in width.

William Hall similarly at Faraker by the side of the yardland, by
estimation 20

rods in length and 20 in width.

Thomas Browne similarly in the same place, by estimation 7 rods in
length and

7 in width.

Pain imposed on all three not to re-offend

Richard Bradley similarly at Faraker, by estimation a quarter of a rood.

Similar

pain.

A swarm of bees taken as strays. In the custody of Adam Browne by
the

assignment of H. Tenaunt, gent, bailiff, for one year and a day.

Another swarm of bees grew from the first swarm within the
aforesaid

year and a day. Taken as goods of the forest.

A pair of shoes siezed by H. Tenaunt, gent, bailiff, as abandoned
goods,

assessed at 20d, out of the goods of [blank] of Leeds,
shoemaker, not

sold at market and forfeited etc.

And wheras ther is controversie who shold make sondrie partes therof it is ordered that every of the said freholders & tenountes shall before that day uppon warning geven by thofficer come to the said spring & take & Receyve ther partes of the said fense. Upon payne of every default 12d.
