1594

Thomas Geldert complains against Henry Claphamson because they bought two sheep together and agreed to divide them afterwards, but Henry has refused to do so.

John Windsor of Settle complains against Henry Claphamson because he broke and entered a certain parcel of soil at the end of his house in Settle, called *a stie roome*, and erected a certain house wall thereupon. As a result he was unable to cover, in English *to theake* the house.

Adam Carre complains against Ralph Hodgson because he depastured his horse on the complainant's corn at Sathwait in Settle.

Jenet Heton widow complains against Christine Watkinson widow re debt of 23s on a loan.

Henry Claphamson complains against Thomas Geldert re debt of 13d for the moiety of a ewe bought by them together, and for grass valued at 19d for his part of the sheep.

Jane Crake widow, executrix of the will of Robert Crake, complains against Brian Cookeson in a plea of debt of 20s which he unjustly detains.

Richard Hardacre complains against William Geldert of Settle re debt of 7s 1d which he owes him for two bushels of wheat.

Henry Tenaunt gentleman complains against Christopher Tatham, William Carre and John Altham junior of Settle in a plea of trespass upon the case. They falsely and unjustly presented that Henry on the south side of the wall in Settle with 4 beasts called 3 *Catlegates unmarked in the forehead*.

Richard Somerscale senior and James Cookeson complain against Christopher Tatham because he took and carried away their ferns, in English *brackans*, lately growing in Settle Wood, and being harvested in stacks.

Richard Somerscale and James Cookeson complain against Hugh Lawson junior for the same reason.

Adam Pailey complains against Richard Pailey because he threw down the complainant's fences and walls at Esheraines in Settle on top of the complainant's crops.

Richard Brayshey and Agnes his wife complain against Richard Kidd and Alice his wife re detinue of a sheet to the value of 5s which Agnes left in the custody of Alice.

John Wiglesworth of Stainton complains against Matthew Whitfeld of H... re debt of 20s for a stone of wool.
