loan.

Robert Kidd senior of Settle complains against Thomas Edlestone late of the
same re debt of 20s for food and drink.

Ralph Hodgeson complains against Robert Kidd of Settle junior because he
entered a certain house in Settle and possessed it.

Giles More of Elroth complains against Christopher Lawson of Lodge re debt
of 17s 8d which he promised to pay for Christopher Tatham by accommodation with
Richard Tatham.

John Armitstead complains against William Brennaunt of Settle re debt of 30s.

Thomas Sailbank complains against Richard Cookson of Settle because he
trampled his corn at Greenrigges.

Alan Wharf complains of Stephen Armitstead because Thomas Cauffeld esq
decd was prosecuting a suit against the said Stephen and a certain William Wildman
in the court of the Duchy of Lancaster in respect of a certain trespass

Richard Midhopp of Dent complains against Christopher Giggleswick of the
same re debt of 8s, ie 3s for 600 iron nails, 3s for food and drink and wool, 3d from a
loan and 21d for other keys bought from the same.

Thomas Howson of Dubcote, executor of John Barrow, complains against
John Tomlinson of Bentham re debt of 30s which he owes him for *womens apparell &
other shapen clothes* bought from the testator. He finds pledges.

Joseph Bankes of Settle complains against Thomas Clerke of Hellifield re debt
for merchandise.

Robert Lawson of Astwick complains against William Cossentine of Calton
saying that he should render to him two pecks of wheat.

[4] Richard Corte of Settle complains of Robert Iveson of the same re debt of
7s 6d; 5s from a loan, 20d for a pair of shoes, and 10d for the same pair of shoes.

Robert Kidd junior complains of Thomas Edlestone of Settle re debt of 20s for
food and drink had and bought from the same at the time of the burial of the
defendant's mother. The defendant is attached for *a paier of bedstockes*, a piece of
wood called *a table*, and one *le presser*.

Miles Cookeson of Settle complains of Barnaby Foster of the same because
the defendant encouraged a certain dog of his to bite six sheep of the complainant's at
[?]Withington in Settle Croftes.
