All that my full and whole Estate, right, title and Interest
Customary hold of, tenant right Claim and Demand whatsoever
of me and unto One parcell of Land lying in a place called Walfaweroff
containing by Estimation six roods both the same more or less, One
parcell of Land lying in a place called Capland, (roods containing
by Estimation one rood both the same more or less, Several parcells of
Land lying in a place called New Close, title, and also one parcell
of Land commonly called and known by the name of Henry
Haw Together with all and singular ways, Easements and Her
editments unto belonging, or therewith usually enjoyed. To have
and to hold the several parcells of Land aforesaid with
them and every of their appurtenances unto the said Jonas Capham
his heirs and assigns for ever, according to the custom of the Man
our of Capham aforesaid, of which the said parcells of Land
are holden, and the said Deceased promises to be occupied in
the said parties their heirs and assigns for ever, without any alle
vation, Exchange, or Addition of Rent whatsoever betwixt them
