TO ALL XPIAN PEOPLE to whome this p'nte wryteinge shall com yt shall read se or heare, John Barrow, Willm Windsor, Richard Winsdor younger, Richarde Preston, Will'm Weatherhead, Richarde Hurtle, Will'm Knowles, Thomas Herde theldre, Thomas Setle, Richard Airton, of Molham in the countye of Yorke. Agnes Weatherhead, and Agnes Hill, of the same Molham widowes, Doe sende greetings in our lord God en'lastinge.
