THIS INDENTURE made the Twnty seventh Day of April in the Year
of our Lord One Thousand seven hundred and seventy two and in
the twelfth year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord King George
the Third BETWEEN Thomas Atkinson late of Malham in the Parish
of Kirkby Malhamdale in the County of York but now of Linton in
the said County Yeoman of the one part and Richard Petty of
Churchsike in the Township of Airton in the Parish of Kirkby in
Malhamdale aforesaid Yeoman of the other part Witnesseth that
the said Thomas Atkinson for and in Consideration of the Sum of
Five Shillings of Lawful Money of Great Britain to him in Hand
paid by the said Richard Petty at or before the Sealing and
Delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
-ledged hath Bargained and Sold and by these presents Doth Bar-
-gain and Sell unto the said Richard Petty his Executors Admins-
-trators and Assigns All those Twenty Sheepgates or Herbages
Grassing and Pasture for Twenty full made sheep to go feed graze
lye and depasture in upon and throughout all that Inclosed and
stinted Pasture or Close called the Ewe Moor situated lying and
being within the Township and Territories of that part of Malham
aforesaid called West Malham according to the present stint used
thereupon together with a proportionable part of the Ground and
Soil of the said Pasture to the said Twenty Sheepgates belonging
in Common with others the Owners and Occupyers of the remainder
of the Sheepgates thereupon And also all and all manner of
Tithes of Corn Grain Hay Wool and Lamb and all other Tithes of
what nature kind or quality soever arising renewing or increasing
or which at any Time or Times hereafter shall arise renew or
increase of in upon or out of the said Sheepgates and premises
and every or any part thereof And also all and all manner of
Oblations and Obventions of what nature kind or quality soever
due or to grow or become due out of the aforesaid premises or
any part thereof or from the Occupyer or Occupyers thereof to
the Rectory or parsonage Improprate of the Parish of Kirkby in
Malhamdale aforesaid All which Sheepgates Tithes and premises
are now or late were in the possession of Richard Atkinson his
Assigns or Undertenants Together with all and singular Ways
Paths Passages Waters Watercourses Watering places Walls fences
Commons Common of Pasture and Turbary Basements Right Libertyes
profits privileges Emoulements Hereditaments and Appurtenances
whatsoever to the said Twenty Sheepgates Tithes and premises
belonging or in any wise appertaining or which to and with the
same or with any part thereof now are or at any time heretofore
have been held used occupied accepted reputed deemed taken or
known as part parcel or member thereof or of any part thereof
And the Reversion and Reversions Remainder and Remainders Rents
Issues and profits of all and singular the said premises and
every part and parcel thereof with the Appurtenances To have and
To hold the said Twenty Sheepgates Tithes of Corn Grain Hay Wool
and Lamb and all and singular other the Hereditaments and premis-
-ses above Bargained and Sold and every part and parcel thereof
with the Appurtenances unto the said Richard Petty his Executors
Adminstrators and Assigns from the Day next before the Day of the
Date hereof for and during and until the full end and Terme of
one whole Year from thenceforth next ensuing and fully to be
compleat and ended Yielding and Paying therefore unto the said
Thomas Atkinson his Heirs and Assigns the rent of one Pepper Corn
at or upon the Feast Day of Saint Michael next ensuing the Date
hereof if the same shall be lawfully Demanded to the intent that
by virtue of these presents and by force of the Statute made for
Transferring of Uses into possession he the said Richard Petty
may be in the actual possession of all and singular the said
premises above Bargained and Sold with the Appurtenances and be
thereby enabled to take and accept of a grant and release of the

Reversion and Inheritance thereof to him and his Heirs to the only proper Use and Behooff of the said Richard Petty his Heirs and Assigns for ever In Witness whereof the said partyes to these presents have hereunto interchangeably set their Hands and Seals the Day and Year first Above written.
