This Indenture made the Twenty fifth day of April in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Seven and in the Seventeenth year of the Reign of his Majesty King George the Third that BETWEEN Josias Rimington of Scothrop in the Parish of Kirkby in Malhamdale and County of York Gentleman of the one part and Henry Lund of Malham in the parish of Kirkby Malhamdale aforesaid Gentleman of the other part WITNESSETH that the said Josias Rimington for and in consideration of the sum of Five Shillings of Lawful Money of Great Britain to him in hand paid by the said Henry Lund at or before the Sealing and Delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged HATH Bargained and Sold and by these presents DOTH Bargain and Sell unto the said Henry Lund his Executors Administrators and Assigns ALL those Sixteen Sheepgates and one full fourth part of a Sheepgate or Herbage Grassing and Pasture for Sixteen full made Sheep and one fourth part of a full made sheep to go Graze lye and Depasture in upon and throughout all that Inclosed and Stinted pasture or close called or commonly known by the name of the Ewe Moor situated lying and being within the Township precincts and Territories of that part of Malham aforesaid called West Malham according to the present Stint used thereupon together with a proportionable part of Ground and Soil of the said Pasture to the said Sixteen Sheepgates and one fourth part of a Sheepgate belonging in Common with others the owners and occupiers of the remainder of the Sheepgates thereupon. And also all and all manner of Tithes of Corn Grain Hay Wooll and Lamb and all other Tithes of what nature kind or quality soever arising renewing or increasing or which at any time or times hereafter shall arise renew or increase of in upon or out of the said Sheepgates and premises and every or any part thereof and also all and all manner of Oblations and Obventions of what native kind or quality soever due to grow or become due out of the aforesaid premises or any part thereof or from the Occupyer or Occupyers thereof to the Rectory or Parsonage Impropriate of the Parish of Kirkby in Malhamdale aforesaid ALL which said Sheepgates Tithes and premises the said Josias Rimington lately bought and purchased of and from Thomas Atkinson of Malham aforesaid Yeoman Together with all and singular Ways Paths Passages Waters Watercourses Watering places Walls Fences Trees Woods Underwoods Commons Common of Pasture and Turbary Easements Rights Liberties Profits Priviledges Encluments Hereditaments and Appurtenances whatsoever to the said Sheepgates Tithes and premises belonging or in anywise have been held used occupied accepted reputed deemed taken or known as part parcel or member thereof or any part thereof and the Reversion and Reversions Remainder and Remainders yearly and Rents Issues and profits thereof and of every part thereof with the Appurtenances TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Sixteen Sheepgates and one fourth part of a Sheepgate Tithes of Corn Grain Hay Wooll and Lamb and all and singular other the Hereditaments and premises above Bargained and Sold and every part and parcel thereof with the Appurtenances unto the said Henry Lund his Executors Administrators and Assigns from the Day next before the Day of the Date hereof for and during and until the full end and Term of one whole year from thenceforth next ensuing and fully to be compleat and ended YIELDING AND PAYING therefore unto the said Josias Rimington his Heirs or Assigns the Rent of one pepper corn at or upon the Feast Day of Saint Michael the Archangel next ensuing the Date hereof if the same shall be lawfully Demanded TO THE INTENT that by virtue of these presents and by force of the

Statute made for the Transferring of leases into possession he the said Henry Lund may be in the actual possession of all and singular the said premises above Bargained and Sold with the Appurtenances and be enabled thereby to take and accept of a grant and Release of the Reversion and In-heritance thereof to him and his Heirs to the only proper Use and Behooff of the said Henry Lund his Heirs and Assigns forever IN WITNESS whereof the said parties to these presents have hereunto Interchangeably set their hands and seals the Day and Year first above written.
