Also I geve the Title and tennant right of my farmhold (wherupon I nowe dwell) [To] John downham my Sonne. Provided that margaret my wiffe have the third parte of the said Tenement with all other thinges what so ever belongethe to the farme and of Right she ought to have duringe her wydowheed according to the Custome of the Lordship of Austwick /. Further my will and intent is that my said wif (if she be with child) have thre roodes of ground thone half mowing grond and thother half Arable ground over and besydes her third parte and the same to be set forth by John Jacson and henry Tate And to possesse the same the space of eight yeares next ensuying the byrthe of such child Item I will that my debtes be paide of my whole goodes The rest of my goodes moveable and Immoveable debtes paid and funerall expences and legaces discha(rg)ed I will and geve the same Equallye to be devieded betwen margart my wif and John my said Sonne. Further I will that Ric(hard) Jacson have the Educacon of my said Sonne untill he come to thadg(the age) of eightene yeares Also I make John Jacson and Ric(hard) Jacson Executors of this my said will and Testament And that they se the same well and truly performed, in everye poynt and Article according to the true purport and meaning hearof / witnesses of the same Geffray Procter John downham henry Tate and Robert Stalmon with other
