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*Extract from Section 40 of the New Highway Act.*

The Surveyor is required from Time to Time to keep a Book, in which shall be entered a just and true and particular Account of all Money which shall have come to his Hands as Surveyor of the Parish, and to whom, and on what Occasion, and for what Work, and in what Place, and on what Day he shall have paid or applied the same, and also an Account of all Tools, Materials, Implements, and other Things provided by him for the Repair of the said Highways; and in case the said Surveyor shall neglect to provide such Book, or to enter therein every Sum received or paid by him within One Week after the same shall have been received or paid, shall forfeit and pay any Sum not exceeding Five Pounds for each Default.
