At a Parish meeting held this day (December the fourth, one thousand eight hundred and ninety four) in the house of Mr Edward Clark in Larkland, in Compliance with the regulations issued by the Local Government Board - Mr John Howson was elected Chairman of the meeting and having read the Circular (marked C 4) explaining the Call for the said meeting, the voters present proceeded to elect a Chairman of the Parish meeting, to hold office until March 1896

Mr Robert Simpson proposed, and Mr John Robinson seconded, Mr Howson as Chairman of the Parish meeting, and ~~he~~ he was elected by an unanimous show of hands.

It was then put to the voters present as to whether they wished to have a Parish Council or not, and it was proposed by Mr Anthony Bradley, and seconded by Mr John Robinson that this meeting was in favour of a Parish Meeting only; same proposal was carried unanimously by a show of hands

There being no further business the meeting was dissolved

The ~~minutes~~ minutes of the last meeting, as well as the subsequent records, made in this book, were read and approved.

\* Sundry accounts for repairs on buildings &c amounting to £1. 4. 3 were presented, and it was proposed by Mr Robert Simpson, seconded by Mr David Wood, and carried, that the Overseers, be authorised to pay the same.

An account was also presented for £4. 15. 1 being legal expenses, incurred in the ejectment of Edward Clark. After due consideration it was resolved, to let this bill stand over until such time as the official Auditor could be communicated with, and his sanction received to pass the same.

The attention of the meeting was then called to the fact, that a bridge over Kettlebeck, on a public foot path, which was washed away in August 1896, has never been replaced by the owner, and Mr David Wood was requested to call the attention of the Settle District Council to the same, as a new bridge is urgently needed.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
