MIXED AND INFANTS':

There is a genuine spirit of industry here. The children like work. Even in the Infants' section all are triers, and consequently much in advance of the normal standard of attainment.

Whereas in all subjects the foundations are well and truly laid, the Drawing and the Singing have special points of merit.

Attention to details mentioned during the inspection would make the work still better, and it is especially to be wished that the children should show no less freedom in oral than in written expression.
