for letting the Offices of Overseer and Constable
for the Township of Lanckland for the term
of 7 Years

The undertaker to attend at a meeting
held at the Stocks Houses in Lanckland on the
last Saturday in every Calendar Month and
produce the Overseers accounts, he is to have
Expence a mile for ordinary Journeys and to
have his expences born when he shall have
occasion to attend at the Sessions or any
extraordinary Journeys which he shall have
to go by order and with the consent of the
Township — He shall also be returned
as Assessor and Collector of the Assessed taxes
and also Surveyor of the Highways within
the said Township

John Shackleton of Lanckland agrees
to do the above offices on the foregoing conditions
for the sum of fifteen Guineas a year which a
meeting of the said Township agrees to give
