To the Churchwarden Lankland

Sir

The reason why I refuse to pay Church Rates to the Township of Lankland for Lands within the Manor of Feizor is, because I have never yet paid a Church Rate for Lands within the Manor of Feizor to Lankland.

But I understand that there is an agreement betwixt the Townships of Hainforth and Lankland that I am to pay a Church Rate to Hainforth for <sup>£</sup>80 and for the remainder to Lankland. Now when I have made any application to the Township of Hainforth, what Lands I was to pay for to Lankland, the only answer I could get, was if it does not amount to <sup>£</sup>80 we will approp the whole, therefore I consider that I am paying for all the Lands within the Manor of Feizor to Hainforth until they point out the Lands which they approp.

But I am willing to pay the rate you demand  
and all arrears for the same if you give me  
a statement in writing what lands you assess  
if the Township of Stairforth agree that I should  
pay it.
