At a lot of homes in Horton are the names of children who are obviously not born there! This census was taken when this area was extremely poor, children being taken from the Work-house and housed with a small fee from Horton Parish Poor Funds, round about Horton, the extra money probably being extremely useful.

The young age of children working is not unusual at that period, they would only receive 'meat and clothes' till quite old, in some cases 21 yrs.
