REPORT BY MR. L.F. GIBBON, H.M.I.INSPECTED ON THE 25TH AND 26TH OCTOBER, 1938.MIXED AND INFANTS':

The school has made substantial progress since the time of the last report. The children are receiving a sound training in school subjects, formal and "recreational", and in habits of good social behaviour.

Some points which were discussed with the Head Mistress at the time of the inspection were :-

- (1) The provision of suitable "margins" on the time-table for milk-drinking, hand-washing and preparation for going home.
- (2) The development of the school Library, to include, on the one hand, some "light" literature and, on the other, a selection of reference books.
- (3) Some allowance on the Infants' Time-Table for Free Play periods, with suitable toys and materials.
