

It should be remembered that in completing the Quarterly Attendance Returns the attendance for the period covered by the Certificate should be ignored.



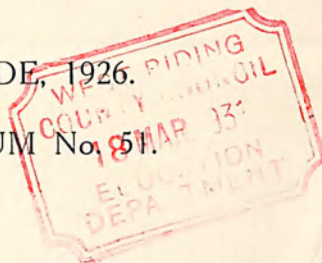
