The Contribution under this Act from Certificated Teachers shall be paid to the Education Department at the prescribed time and in the prescribed manner by the teachers or their employers; and the receipt of the Education Department for the amount of a contribution paid by the employer of a teacher shall be a good discharge for the like amount of remuneration otherwise payable to the teacher.—(Sec. 3 (1) Elementary School Teachers (Superannuation) Act, 1898).

The Education Department or Secretary of State in forwarding any grant payable by them to the managers of the school or college shall forward with it the receipt of the Education Department for the deductions made, specifying separately the deduction made on account of each teacher, and the managers of the school or college shall, if required by any such teacher within one year of the receipt being so forwarded, give the teacher a copy of so much of the receipt as relates to him.—(Rule 10 (4) Elementary School Teachers Superannuation Rules, 1899).
