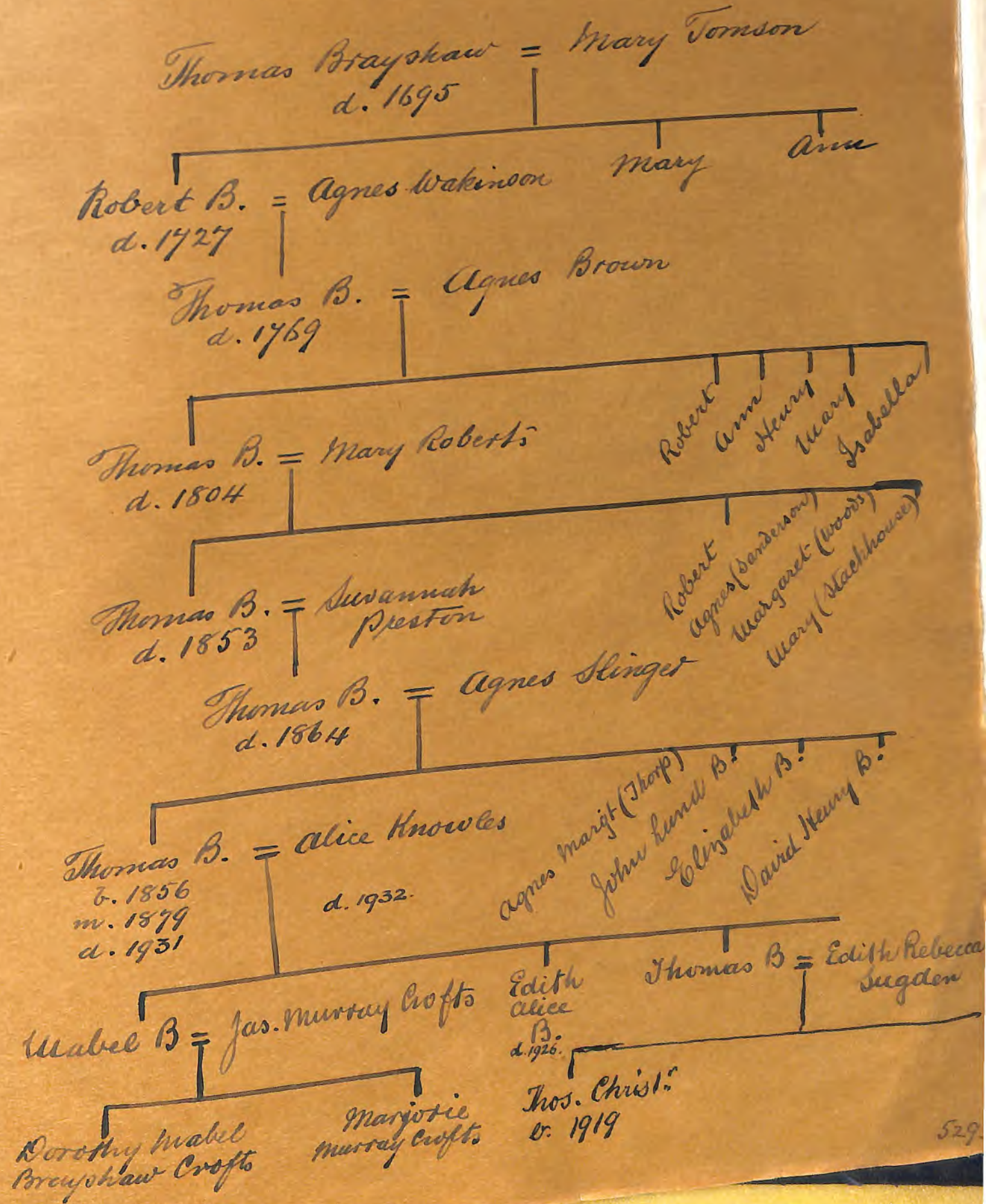
From Giggleswick Parish Registers.

- The earliest entries in the Giggleswick Registers relating to the Brayshaw family are:-
- 1558. Dec? "Robtus Braischa" (buried.)
 - 1559. 1st Oct. "Alicia, filia Johes Braischaue" (bapt.)
 - 1560. 18 Aug. "Godfridus Silverwood" } married.
 - "Isabella Brasthene" }
 - 1560. 29 June. "Willus, filius Rob. Braishay." (bapt.)
 - 1561. 11 April. "Margareta Braishay nathe." (bapt.)
 - 1561. 20 Sept. "Richus Braischaie." (buried.)
 - 1562. 7 Aug. "Oliverus et Jana Braischaie gonelli" }
 "Rich^o Braischaie." (bapt.)

Mem: There are 171 Brayshaw & entries in the Registers between 1558 and 1626.

The earliest record of the Brayshaw family in the ancient parish of Giggleswick is the entry in list of Tax-payers in 1379, where it is stated that "Henricus de Braychawe" of Stairforth paid 4d poll-tax. (See page 503 of this vol.)
