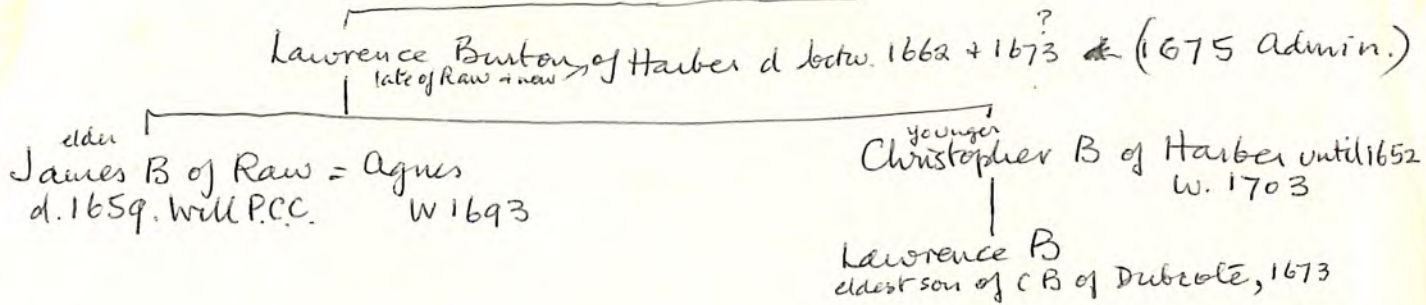

Christopher d 1650, will: (to son Lawrence + grandson James)
1. house + land at Dubcoate ^{1/2 rent} ex Leunards to Battersby to Burton
2. west end of firehouse at Dubcoate ^{lands. 5/8 rent} ex Armisted to Bateson → John Litton to Burton;
3. lands, ex Leunard → Bateson → Miles Tailor → Burton
4. lands, ^{Murrowdale} ~~ex Leunard~~ ex Leunard → Howson → Bateson ^{gran} → Burton
5. lands, ex Leunards → ward of Rawe → Burton
6. common, ex Ed Howson + Procter → Burton
7. common, ex Armisted + Lakeland → Burton
8. arable, ex Ward → Burton
9. East end of firehouse etc. ex Leunards → ^T Howson of Newhouses →
Ed. Howson of Newhouses + Thomas Procter of N Brikwith

Lawrence, indenture of 1652: (to Christopher of Harber)
1. part of ancient cottage etc. at Dubcoate, ex Bateson (2 above) 9/8 rent
2. ancient cott + ten. etc. at Dubcoate (1 above) 7/2 rent
3. land, Murrowdale, ex Bateson. (4 above)
4. 2 closes Dansmires + Skarcloe A Armisted → David Dowbiggin of Newlanduse (tenant)
5-13 other lands.
