Killed in Germany

An 18-year-old Bradford airman, with Craven associations, A.C.1 Alan Taylor, of 11, Boyd Avenue, Thornbury, the youngest son of Mr. and Mrs. F. H. Taylor, has been killed in a road accident in Germany.



A.C. Taylor, who volunteered eight months ago for four years, had been in Germany only a fortnight. He was a motor transport mechanic.

A.C. Taylor was well known in North Ribblesdale, being evacuated to Horton-in-Ribblesdale at the age of five. He attended Helwith Bridge Modern School and Lapage Street Modern School, Bradford, later returning to Horton-in-Ribblesdale to study farming. Before joining the Air Force he worked for Mr. T. Rayner, Dubcote Farm, Horton-in-Ribblesdale. He was a member of the Horton-in-Ribblesdale Y.F.C. and played football for Horton-in-Ribblesdale.

A.C. Taylor was buried at Hanover Military Cemetery on Wednesday.
