

Memorandum that the day and yeare last writtten of peaceable possession and seizen was had and taken by the within named John Tanstall in his proper person of all that these obland meadow or pasture ad it is now divided in two commonly called or known by the name of these Close containing by estimation one acre and an halfe more or less. And alsoe of all those two closed or inclosed peeces of ground commonly called & knowne by the name of old Stannissex containing by estimation four acres more or less (both within mentioned) and afterwards full and peaceable possession hereof and seizen of the same was by him given and delivered to the within named Lawrence Tanstall in his proper person in name of all the within mentioned premises to be executed according to the true intent and meaning of these presents within mentioned this deed being first sealed and delivered in the presence of
