**This Indenture** made the Ninth Day of February, in the Eleventh year of the Reigne of our Sovereigne Lord William the third of England  
Stokland ffraunce and Irelans King defender of the faith by Annoq; Ano 1699. **Betwene** Thomas Tunstall of Beverley in the County of Yorke Yeoman —  
Some ffche of John Tunstall late of Horton in Ribblesdale in the said County of Yorke his late ffathir Decreas'd of the one part, And Laurentie Tunstall of Dubroats  
in the parish of Horton aforesaid Yeoman ffrauncis Bowson of Dubroats aforesaid Yeoman of the other part **witnesseth** that the said Thomas Tunstall for con-  
sideration of ffye shillings of turrant English money to him before Sealing hercoss paid, by the said Laurentie Tunstall ffrauncis Bowson, the receipt whereof  
she doth hereby acknowledge & thercess doth acquitt. Quod istud hanc the said Laurentie Tunstall ffrauncis Bowson their heires executo & ffolde forever by these presents  
And for divers other good causes and considerations him therunto moving, **hath** granted beryonged & sold. And by these presents doth grant beare and keepe  
unto the said Laurentie Tunstall ffrauncis Bowson their Executors Administratores & assignes. All that his close of land meadow or pasturage as it is now  
divided in two parts commonly called or knowne by the name of ffarr Rose, containing by estimation one acre or less be the same more or less, with the  
house or Barne standing in the said Rose, And also all those his two closes, or inclosed parcels of ground commonly called ffowne by the name of Old  
Stannibarke, containing by estimation fourtys acres be they more or less, Adjoyning on the North side of a close late of the said John Tunstall called Gyll Dale  
And likewise all that his close of land meadow or pasturage, commonly called or knowne by the name of the Bent, containing by estimation fourtys acres be  
the same more or less, all which said premises are situate lying & being within the Parish ffelds & bounds of Horton in Ribblesdale aforesaid  
in the said County of Yorke now in the tenure or occupancy of the said Laurentie Tunstall, & together with all singular wayes waters, waters,  
houses, patres, passayes, wals, hedges, ditches, flened trees, woodes underwoodes commones common of pasturage, common of Turbarie, rights hereditarie priviledges profits,  
comodities hereditamentes appurtenantes whatsoever to the said several posses & possesse above hercby Barname & sold, belonging or in any wise of right  
appertainente or therewith or late used occupied or enjoyed or accepted knowne reputed or taken to be as part partell or membrall thereof, or of any part or  
partell therof, And the reversion & remainder & together with the Rents and profits of the premises of every part and partell  
therof **To have and to hold** the said ffours closes of land meadow or pasturage & all singular other the premises above hercby Barname &  
sold, or intended or intended to be hercby Barname & sold every part & partell therof with their & every of their appurtenantes, unto the said Laurentie  
Tunstall ffrauncis Bowson their Executors Administratores & assignes from the day before the date of these presents for during the term of one whole year  
from thence next ensuing fully to be complete ended, **Holding** & paymyn therefore unto the said Thomas Tunstall his heires or assignes, the Rent of  
one pippes, tornes, all the feast of St. Mutchell the first daye only by the same be then demanded. To the intent that by vertue of these presents & of the  
Statute for transffering of vses into possession the said Laurentie Tunstall ffrauncis Bowson may be in the actual possession of the premises above  
enabled to take & cattel of a maner release of the reversion & inheritance thereof to them & their heires forever. **In witnessse** whereof the  
partys aboveaid to this Indenture have interchangably sett their handes and sealed the day and year first above written.
