This Indenture

made the Twelfth day of February in the Twelfth year of the reign of our sovereigne Lady elme by the grace of God Queene of great Brittaines ffraunce and Irelande defender of the ffayth &c. Anno Dni 1573: before us Cluthony Dowbiggin of Howlandhouse in the parish of Horton in Ribblesdale in the County of Yorkes a yoman of the one parte and Thomas Wilson junr. of Giggleswick in the sayd County gent. of the other pte witnesseth that the sayd Cluthony Dowbiggin for his better pformance and confirmacion of an exchange made and agreed upon betwene him the sayd Cluthony and the sayd Thomas Wilson had the sayd Cluthony Dowbiggin Hath given granted and confirmed and by these p'sules doth give grant and confirme unto the sayd Thomas Wilson and his heires **Al** that parcell of ground & with its aptaunces lying and being at a certayne place there comonly called the Whitesike within the Libertyes of Horton aforesayd & by estimation vno Rood and fiveteens ffalls be it more or lesse the Lande of the sayd Thomas Wilson lying both West North and South & there of for and in Exchange and full recompense for one Dale or parcell of ground of the sayd Thomas Wilson called the Brown haws lying within Horton aforesayd by estimation vno Rood or thereabouts the grounds of the sayd Cluthony lying on the North side thereof & **to have and to hold** the sayd parcell of ground lying at Whitesike aforesayd unto the sayd Thomas Wilson his heires and assignes for ever for and in Exchange of and for that parcell or Dale of ground called the Brown haws of him the sayd Thomas Wilson **and** the sayd Thomas Wilson on his pte hath likewise given granted and confirmed and by these p'sules doth give grant and confirme unto the sayd Cluthony Dowbiggin and his heires **Al** that the sayd Dale or parcell of ground called the Brown haws with all its aptaunces **to have and to hold** the sayd Dale or parcell of ground with the aptaunces unto the sayd Cluthony Dowbiggin his heires and assignes for ever for and in Exchange of and for the sayd parcell of ground of him the sayd Thomas Wilson lying at Whitesike aforesayd **and** the sayd Thomas Wilson for & himselfe his heires and assignes the sayd Dale or parcell of ground called the Brown haws with all its aptaunces soe given in Exchange unto the sayd Cluthony Dowbiggin and his heires as aforesayd unto the sayd Cluthony Dowbiggin his heires and assignes for ever as well from all former and other gifts grants bargaines sales and Innumbrances whatsoever as also against all and all maner person and persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and for ever defend by these p'sules **In witness** where of the sayd partyes to the severall partes of these Indentures of Exchange Interchangeably have sett their handes and Seales the day and years first above writton: /
