As the said Ellen Green have Assented to take of My Brother Anthony Dowbiggin
of Westlandhouse in the Parish of County Aforesaid Woman the sum of forty pounds
for & in lieu of all my Right title Interest Property Claim & Demand whatsoever
of in to or out of All the Estates of what kind or Nature soever Real or personal
Whose Lawt Money or good Whatsoever or where soever Which did belong to
or was in the possession of my late Brother Lawrence Dowbiggin at the
time of his Deaths And not by him disposed or by Will or otherwise &
Now know ye that I the said Ellen ~~Dowbiggin~~ Green do hereby Acknow-
ledge that I have at & before the Execution thereof of my said Brother Anthony Dowbig-
gins last made had & received of & from my said Brother Anthony Dowbig-
gin the said sum of forty pounds good & lawful money of Great Britain &
And that in Consideration thereof of the said Ellen Green do by these presents for-
bear me my Heirs Executors & Administrators Remits Respects & for ever quit
Claim unto my said Brother Anthony Dowbiggin his Heirs Executors Adminis-
trators & Assigns All the Right title Interest Property Claim & Demand whatsoever
which I the said Ellen Green now have or had or which I my Heirs Executors Ad-
ministrators or Assigns or any of us at any time hereafter shall can or may
have Respects or Claims of whatsoever kind or Nature ~~belong to my said Brother Anthony Dowbiggin~~
that Whither I the said Ellen Green nor my Heirs Executors or Administrators
or any other person or persons lawfully Claiming by from or under us them
or any of them shall or may by any Way or Means hereafter have
Claim Challenges or Demand any Estate right title or Interest of in to or out
of the said premises or any Part thereof either at Law or in Equity But
from all & every Action Right Estate title Interest Property Claim & Demand
of in to or out of the same shall by these presents be utterly Excluded & for-
ever Forfeited In Witness Whereof I the said Ellen Green have hereunto
Set my hand & Seal the twenty second Day of November in the fourteenth
Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the Second by ye Grace of God
Over Great Britain France & Ireland King Defender of the Faith & so forth
And in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred & forty 1740.
