# His Indenture

Made the twenty-ninth day of April in the twenty-first Year of the reign of our Sovereign our  
Lord George the Second by the Grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender  
of the faith and so forth And in the Year of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred forty and eight Between xx  
William Kidd of Ribblesdale in the Parish of Horton in Ribblesdale in the County of York Yeoman of the one part and  
Thomas Dowbiggin of Greelandhouse in the same Parish and County Yeoman of the other part **Witnesseth** that for and  
in Consideration of the sum of five Shillings of lawfull British money to the said William Kidd in hand paid by the said xx  
Thomas Dowbiggin before the Execution of these presents (the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) He the said William  
Kidd hath Bargained and Sold And by these presents doth Bargain and Sell unto the said Thomas Dowbiggin his xx  
Executors Administrators and Assigns **One whole Cattle gate or Grass** for one full year Beast with the Ground and  
Soil thereof in upon and throughout all that situated Pasture commonly called Low-moor situate within the Parish of Horton in xx  
Ribblesdale aforesaid with all and every the Ways Waters Watercourses hedges fences Woods Underwoods Commons  
Conouf of pasture and Barbary rights Liberties profits privileges advantages hereditaments and Appurtenances whatsoever to the  
said cattle gate belonging or in any wise appertaining or with the same now or at any time heretofore had used or enjoyed or annexed  
reputed or taken as part or member thereof And the Reversion and Reversions remainder and Remainders and all yearly and  
other Rents Issues and Profits thereof **To have and To hold** the said cattle gate or Beast-graze and the Ground and soil  
thereof and all other the hereditaments and Premises herein before mentioned and intended to be hereby Bargained and sold with  
the Appurtenances unto the said Thomas Dowbiggin his Executors Administrators and Assigns from the Day next before the Day  
of the Date hereof for and during and unto the full end and Term of one whole Year from thence next ensuing and fully to be compleat  
and ended **Yielding and paying** therefore unto the said William Kidd his heirs or assigns the Rent of one peppercorn  
on the last Day of the said Term if the same be then lawfully demanded **To the intent and purpose** that by Virtue hereof and  
of the Statute for transforming Usos into Posession he the said Thomas Dowbiggin may be in the actual possession of the said  
premises and thereby enabled to take a Grant and Release of the Reversion freehold and inheritance thereof to him and his xx  
heirs for ever In such Sort manner and form as in and by a certain Indenture of Release intended to bear date the Day nexte  
after the Day of the Date hereof and to be made between the said William Kidd and Joannet his Wife of his one part and the  
said Thomas Dowbiggin of the other part the same shall be granted released and conveyed **In witness** whereof the  
said parties to these presents have interchangingably subscribed and set their hands and Seals the Day and Year first above written &c.
