# His Indenture

made the twentieth day of November the seventh year of the reign of our sovereign Lord George the third by the grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King defender of the faith and so forth and in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and sixty six **Between** James Weatherhead of Linton in the Parish of Crowliffe the ~~parish of Crowliffe~~ and County of Northamptonshire Gentleman of the one part and Thomas Dowbiquin of Newland house in the Parish of Norton in the County of Ribblesdale and County aforesaid Gentleman of the other part **Witnesseth** that the said James Weatherhead for and in consideration of the sum of five shillings of lawful British money to him well and truly in hand paid by the said Thomas Dowbiquin at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and for diverse other good causes and valuable considerations the said James Weatherhead therunto moving **hath** bargained and sold and by these presents **Doth** bargain and sell unto the said Thomas Dowbiquin his Executors Administrators and Assigns **All that** Dale or parcel of Ground in the Township of Norton aforesaid called Trentier Dale lying on the East side of the River Ribble and adjoining on the West to the Lands of Robert Foster on the North to the Lands of Mr Christopher Clapham and on the South to the Lands of Thomas Foster Together with all and singular Turbarie easements rights liberties profits privileges Advantages emoluments hereditaments and appertaining **To have and to hold** the said Dale or parcel of Ground called Trentier Dale with all and singular the rights members appertinances and appurtenances therunto belonging unto the said Thomas Dowbiquin his Executors Administrators and Assigns from the day next before the day of the date of these presents for during and until the full end and term of one whole year from thence next ensuing and fully to be complete and ended **Yielding and paying** therefore unto the said James Weatherhead his heirs or Assigns the rent of one pepper Corn only at the feast of Pentecost if demanded to the intent that by virtue of these presents and by force of the Statute for transferring of uses into possession the said Thomas Dowbiquin may be in the actual possession of the said premises and be enabled thereby to accept and take a grant and release of the reversion and inheritance thereof to him his heirs and Assigns for ever **In Witness** whereof the said parties to these presents have hereunto interchanged by act their hands and seals the day and year first above written
