In the Name of God Amen I Thomas Hesteden of Horton  
in y<sup>e</sup> Parish of Horton in Ribblesdale in y<sup>e</sup> County of York  
Gentleman being now far advanced in years but of sound  
perfect and disposing Mind Memory and understanding  
Do for y<sup>e</sup> settling of my temporal Concerns make Ordain  
Publish and Declare this my last Will and Testament  
in Manner and form following (that is to say) First I my  
Will and Mind that all my Just Debts Funerall Expences  
and y<sup>e</sup> Charges of y<sup>e</sup> Probate of this my Will ~~and~~ be paid  
by my Executors herein after named out of my Personal  
Estate with all convenient speed after my Decease I give  
and Devise unto my Nephew Bryan Hesteden y<sup>e</sup>

Mesuage wherein I now live with all other Mesuag-  
Houses Gardens Tenements Cloves Lands Grounds Gras-  
ing and Hereditaments Situate at and near Horton  
aforesaid (except Townend Croft and y<sup>e</sup> Old Howstead which

to him and his Heirs for ever; I give and Devise unto  
my Nephew Christo<sup>r</sup> Other all that Mesuage and  
Tenement Houses Barms Cloves Lands Grounds and  
Grasping with y<sup>e</sup> Ground and Soil thereof which I

two pieces of Land in Hay worth which I had in exchange  
of Mybrocter of Sutton together with all rights Royalties  
tenements and appurtenances belonging to all or

Barrack before excepted all which are standing lying and being  
ad Horton aforesaid with all there rights Royalties and  
appurtenances to hold to her and her Heirs for ever. I give  
and Devise unto my Brother William Healden all my  
Customary Estate ad Hevide in y.<sup>e</sup> Barish of Horton aforesaid  
and now in y.<sup>e</sup> Occupation of Chris.<sup>t</sup> Bateson as Farmer  
thereof together with all Rights Royalties Members and  
appurtenances thereunto belonging to Hold to him and  
his Heirs for ever so that he may be more able to make it  
up to his Children which I have left nothing to as they are  
all equally Dear and alike to me I also give and Bequeath  
unto my Nieces Margared Other and Elizabeth Other  
y.<sup>e</sup> sum of one Hundred Pounds apiece to be paid by my Execu-  
tors out of my Personal Estate six Months after my Decease  
over and above the three Hundred Pounds which my Brother  
Bryan Healden left to my Sister Elizabeth Others Children  
I also give and Bequeath unto my late Mothers half Brothers  
and Sister or to y.<sup>e</sup> Children of those that may be De<sup>d</sup> the sum  
of Forty Pounds to be paid by my Executors in such shares or
