REPAIRING PROCEDURE

Foliate

Pull

Fumigate ✓ Thymol

Dry Clean ✓

Nylon

Wash ✓ 0.05 gm/l. Ortho phenyl phenol in ^{last} rinse

Bleach

Deacidify ✓ 1:1 Calcium hydroxide + water

Size ✓ 4% Gelatin

Paste Sodium alginate + arrowroot

Jap Tissue 15 - used for tears

Hand Made Paper Balleian 32 lb

Tissueing - for original backing

Lens Tissue & Primal

Laminating Tissue

Parchment

pH = 5 → 7.5

COMMENTS

Large patch toned down with Indian ink + topone. Small holes filled in with pulp. Difficult to prevent backing^{from} buckling because grain of one part of the map runs in the opposite direction to backing + main part of map.
