This Memorial was Registered the first day of March 1704 at Eight in the Morning

An Indenture of Lease bearing date the Fifteenth day of January in the third year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lady Anne by the grace of God of England Scotland France and Ireland Queen Defender of the Faith etc. Annoque Domini One Thousand Seven Hundred and Four made Between Henry Wigglesworth of Long Preston in the County of York Gent on the one part and John Armitstead of Giggleswick in the said County of York Master of Arts on the other part And one other Indenture of Release bearing date the Sixteenth day of January in the said third year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lady Anne made Between the partys aforesaid And of and concerning all that one Close called Short Wattakers by estimation Four acres (excepting one parcell of ground therein by estimation Five roods) lying within the Township of Giggleswick And also of and concerning all those Rents called Thornton Rents with all Fines Issues and yearly profitts whatsoever reserved by any Demise out of any Houses or parcels of Land within the Townshipp of Giggleswick and heretofore made payable to the Heirs of one Robert Thornton which which two Indentures of Lease and Release are Witnessed by Ambrose Wigglesworth of Long Preston Yeoman William Clark of Long Preston Labourer and William Carr junr of Settle Mercer

Reg^d. the Twenty Ninth of Oct 1708 at Ten in the forenoon

An Indenture of a Lease bearing date the Twenty Second day of October in the year of our Lord God One Thousand Seven Hundred and Eight Between Thomas Lawson of Giggleswick in the County of York Gent on the one part And John Atkinson of Roomhouses within the parish of Giggleswick in the said County of York Yeoman on the other part of three Closes or parcels of Inclosed Arable and meadow ground lying within the Township precincts and territories of Giggleswick aforesaid called Great Watticarrs Watticarr head Benson leys alias Beggar Greaves and one Barne therein standing with their appurtenances by which said Lease the said premisses are Conveyed to the said John Atkinson his Executors Administrators and Assignes from the day of the date of the said Indenture of Lease for the term of four hundred & fifty years from thence next ensuing Which said Indenture is witnessed by Richard Jackson of Clapham Thomas Ripley of Clapham John Husband of Crenerigg William Atkinson of Littlebanke Mathew Watkinson of Giggleswick and Allan Bateman of Old hutton in the County of Westmorland Carrier
