

Thomas Stewart, Knaresborough farmer, a tragic tale

Thomas Stewart 1812 - 1885 and his wife **Nelly Cundall** arrived in Settle from Knaresborough just a few years after they were married in 1835. Thomas began working as a servant at Stackhouse Hall, and then for the *Birkbecks* at Ashfield. They lived at Rose Cottage next to Ashfield estate. both before and after the railway was built close to their front door.

Thomas won numerous awards at the North Ribblesdale Agricultural Show for his pigs, fruit and veg. In both articles [1], innkeepers *Mrs (Henry) Ayrton* of the Royal Oak and *Mrs (Thomas) Wetherell* at the Golden Lion also did well.

Thomas and Nellie had four daughters and a son but were predeceased by four of them. In 1861, daughter **Maria** worked as a 'nurse' for the second vicar, *Rev William Pierson* who, at that time, had a toddler John Ernest at the parsonage on Station Road. Maria died in 1870 aged 30.

Daughter **Annie Eliza** advertised her dressmaking business in 1862 [5C], from 'New Road' now Station Road but died aged 34. **Martha** was 24 and **George** just five. Martha is remembered on her's parents' stone (with an incorrect date) and her own stone.



Nelly died in 1876, followed by Thomas in 1884. After her father died, youngest daughter **Eleanor** emigrated to Canada and married Scot **Samuel Jamison** out there. Unfortunately she died 2 years later, but somehow, someone organised the inscription of her name on her parents' stone.
