

Three archaeology walks around Ingleborough

The three files in this section hold archaeology walks around Ingleborough:

1. Ribblehead to Selside – 8km (5 miles)
2. South House, Sulber and Upper Pasture – 7km (4.5 miles)
3. Ribblehead, Great Douk and Southerscales – 9km (5.5 miles)

There is a map within each booklet, but a full Ordnance Survey map will be helpful:

The walks were created in 2016 by the Ingleborough Archaeology Group, with funding from Stories in Stone. The leader of the project was Chris Bonsall, who created the walks with help from various members of the Group. The booklets were created by John Cuthbert.

An additional feature of the walks is a phone app for Android and iPhone users which shows your location on a map and brings up on screen various items listed in the booklets.
