



This Indenture

made the *Thirtieth* Day of *May* in the *30th*

Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lady VICTORIA by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, QUEEN, Defender of the Faith, and in the Year of our LORD One Thousand Eight Hundred and sixty *eight*

in the County of York BETWEEN *Thomas Kirkbright of Lofthouse* of the one part, and *Cornelius Kirkbright, his son on the other part. And Abraham Stott of Bishop Thornton in the County of York*

of the other part; WITNESSETH, That the said *Cornelius Kirkbright* hath of his own free will, and with the consent of the said *Thomas Kirkbright his Father*

Abraham Stott of Bishop Thornton put and bound himself Apprentice to and with the said *Abraham Stott* and with *him* after the manner of an Apprentice to dwell, remain, and serve from the *Thirtieth* day of *May* 1868 until the *Thirtieth* day of *December* 1871 for, during, and until the Term of *3 1/2* years thence next following well and faithfully shall serve *his* Secrets shall keep, *his* lawful commands shall do, Fornication or Adultery shall not commit, Hurt or Damage to his said M^{aster} he shall not do, or consent to be done, but to the utmost of his power shall prevent it and forthwith his said M^{aster} thereof warn: Taverns or Alehouses he shall not haunt or frequent, unless it be about his M^{aster's} Business there to be done: at Dice, Cards, Tables, Bowls, or any other unlawful Games he shall not play: the Goods of his said M^{aster} he shall not waste nor them lend, or give to any Person without his said M^{aster's} Licence: Matrimony within the said Term he shall not contract, nor from his M^{aster's} Service at any time absent himself; but as a true and faithful Apprentice shall order and behave himself towards his said M^{aster} and all *his* family, as well in Words as Deeds during the said Term: And a true and just Account of all his said M^{aster's} Goods, Chattles and Money committed to his Charge, or which shall come to his Hands, faithfully he shall give at all Times when thereunto required by his said M^{aster}, *his* Executors, Administrators, or Assigns. AND the said *Thomas Kirkbright, his heirs, executors, and administrators with hereby*

covenant, promise and agree with the said Abraham Stott, his executors, administrators and assigns that he will find and provide his son sufficient wearing apparel for the whole time of his sons apprenticeship. And also that Thomas Kirkbright covenants and agrees to pay to Abraham Stott the sum of Five Pounds as apprenticeship fee, the one half to be paid now, and the other half to be paid at the expiration of twelve calendar months from this date.

for *him* self *his* Executors and Administrators, doth covenant, promise and agree by these Presents, with and to the said *Thomas Kirkbright of Lofthouse* and also with and to the said Apprentice, That he the said *Abraham Stott of Bishop Thornton* his Executors, or Administrators, shall and will teach, learn and instruct him the said Apprentice, or cause him to be taught, learned, or instructed in the *art, trade, and business of Wheelwright and Joiner* which the said M^{aster} now useth, after the best manner that *he* or they may or can, with all Circumstances thereto belonging: And also *hereby* agrees to find the said apprentice sufficient meat, drink, washing, lodgings, and tools to work with during the whole time of his apprenticeship.

Cornelius Kirkbright to have 1 week Holiday at Midsummer Feast, and 3 days at Christmas and 3 days at Whitsun tide yearly.

And for the true performance of all and singular the Covenants and Agreements aforesaid, each of the parties aforesaid doth bind himself unto the other firmly by these Presents. IN WITNESS whereof, the Parties above named to these present Indentures interchangeably have set their Hands and Seals the day and Year above written.
