Snowy photos from the Past

The photo on the front page of this edition, repeated to the right, was taken during the winter of 1963, this picture shows Eric Foster who farmed at Little Newton with some of the deer on the hills above the Village.



The photo below was taken during May 1935. The location is the land on Kendal Road. The houses were yet to be built and the land contained allotments. The school would be to the left of the picture. The houses in the picture which are quite recognisable comprise Peel Terrace, Peel Cottage and Glendair.



The picture below – also May 1935 – shows Haw Lane leading up to the original Railway Station House and associated buildings. This house was pulled down during the mid 1960's. Originally built for Hellifield's first Station Master Mr William Ash by the North Western Railway Company in the years 1847 – 1851.
