**BANK TOP**

2 Railway viaduct c1860, of brick and sandstone over the R greta (past the confluence of doe and twiss.) rock faced gritstone with chisel drafted margins. Hole or lewis/dog. 2 railway companies from N and S never agreed so a sation at each end and pople walked from one sation to another. Midland? Rail the built the Morecombe line?

3. House. Corner of Bank top and station exit road. Old road out of Ingleton. Much altered house like many in Ingleton. Large extruded chimney stack on gable wall. Roof lines? Date over door- 1733 JandJ. It has flat-faced mullions. Door still chamfered but narrow. Note broad tooling of 18thC date. *315 on TA 1836*

4 1887 view point (across road)plaque commemorates planting The Brow. (Qu Vic?) Ingleton became a tourist attraction for its romantic and spectacular "glens". Thornton Force (waterfall) James Huttton geologist drew it to illustrate the Earth must be very old. View of the viaduct. Note the many 19thC cottages. This was an industrial site with tannaries and water powered mills on the river.

5 walk along Bank Top to Pear Tree Cottage /Bank Top with 17thC chamfered mullions remaining.

5 Crofts barn (converted) Cart arch on L.  
6 A 19thC terrace with bay windows, gables to attics (garrets). Note weathered limestone pavement on walltops.(used in bradford)

7 Craven heiffer inn. Lots of pots on stacks.4 bays. Chunky sash windows, once mullions? Seems to have a yard.

8 further on (west) is a stable block or manufactouy/workshop. Industrial eg weaving?

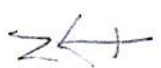
24 The Iron Bridge, just past toll House.

K.K. Road

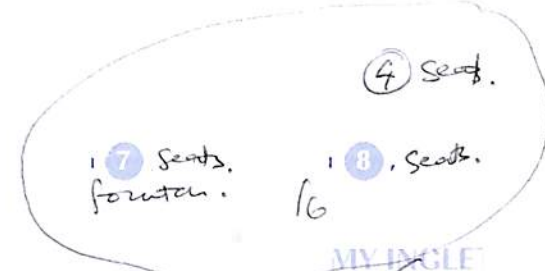


Return to village by Main St, alongside
