THIS IS THE LAST WILL of me WALTER PERCY INMAN of Lanchester House, Kettlewell, Skipton, Yorkshire Provision Merchant

1. I REVOKE all other wills and testamentary dispositions by me heretofore made

2. I APPOINT my wife Eleanor Ann Inman and my niece Frances Mary Inman (hereinafter called "my Trustees") to be the Executrixes and Trustees of this my Will

3. I GIVE the following legacies free from all duty and costs namely:-

(a) TO all the children in Kettlewell under fourteen years of age whose parents have resided in Kettlewell for at least five years immediately prior to my death the sum of One Pound each

(b) TO my niece Mary Heseltine the sum of Ten Pounds

(c) TO my niece Annie Raw the sum of Ten Pounds

(d) TO my nephew Joseph Raw the sum of Twenty Pounds

(e) TO Kadge Holdsworth of Kettlewell the sum of Five Pounds

(f) TO Margaret Harrington of Starbottan the sum of Five Pounds

(g) TO Mrs John Hill of Conistone the sum of Five Pounds

(h) TO Iona Hall of Conistone the sum of Five Pounds

(i) TO Robert Featherall of Skipton the sum of Five Pounds

(j) TO Martha Close of Starbottan the sum of Five Pounds

(k) TO Alex Cryle of Kettlewell the sum of Five Pounds

(l) TO Arthur Rushton of Kettlewell the sum of Five Pounds

(m) TO my great niece Shirley Raw the sum of One Hundred Pounds

(n) TO Stella Large of Kettlewell the sum of Ten Pounds

(o) TO Bessie Backhouse of Kettlewell the sum of Twenty Pounds

(p) TO Laura Lallinson of Kettlewell the sum of Five Pounds

(q) TO Margaret Carr of Hagg Dyke the sum of Five Pounds

(r) TO Angela Dawson Johnson of West Burton the sum of Twenty Pounds

4. I GIVE all my wearing apparel to James Dinsdale and James Smith in equal shares free of duty such division to be made by my Trustees

5. I GIVE my gold watch and chain and ten sovereigns to my brother Ernest Jesse Inman free of duty

6. I GIVE to Luriel Santo-Brown the sum of Ten Pounds free of duty and to my niece Mary Inman my collection of water, dresser and delft rack also free of duty

7. I GIVE to my said wife Eleanor Ann Inman all the rest of my articles

8. I GIVE to the Churchwardens of Kettlewell Church free of all duty Two Hundred Pounds (nominal value) of my 3% War Stock the income arising therefrom to be used for the annual Sunday school prize

9. AS to all the rest of my estate and effects both real and personal I DEVISE AND BEQUEATH the same unto my Trustees. THAT AND THAT my Trustees shall receive and pay the income therefrom to my said wife during her life or permit her to receive the same AND from and after the death of my said wife then I DIRECT my Trustees to distribute my estate as follows:-

(i) I GIVE AND BEQUEATH to the Trustees of the Kettlewell Village Hall the sum of Fifty Pounds free of duty and costs to be used towards forming an endowment fund for the benefit of the said Village Hall and I DECLARE that the income from the said sum of Fifty Pounds shall be used for such purposes in connection with the said village hall as the Trustees of such village hall shall decide

(ii) I GIVE AND BEQUEATH to my Trustees the sum of Two hundred Pounds free of duty and costs for the erection of a stained glass window in Kettlewell Church in memory of the Inman family

(iii) I GIVE AND BEQUEATH to my Trustees the sum of Fifty Pounds free of duty and costs for the erection of a stained glass window in Conistone Church in memory of the Inman family

(iv) AS to all the residue of my estate and effects both real and personal I GIVE DEVISE AND BEQUEATH the same unto my niece Frances Mary Inman absolutely but subject nevertheless to the payment of an annuity of Fifty Pounds per annum to my brother John Inman during his life

10. I DESIRE to record the fact that it is my wish that my property at Kettlewell and Guildford devised to my said niece Frances Mary Inman shall not be sold but shall be retained by my said niece

11. I HEREBY AUTHORISE my Trustees to retain my investments during the lifetime of my wife AND I DECLARE that my Trustees shall not be held in any way responsible for any loss occasioned by such retention
