

1793 Valuation of the tithes of Rylstone

In June 1793, Benjamin Chambers, acting as agent for the Duke of Devonshire, made a valuation of the tithes of Rylstone and his report is a good account of the district at that "The Township of Rylstone is a chapelry within the Parish of Burnsall. The Duke of Devonshire is Lord of the Manor and by far the greatest owner. The Duke's Hall Farm called the demesne land contains about 500 acres and is said to tithe free, but if it was not, there is no corn or plough land upon the farm this year. There is said to be £3-10-0 paid to the Rector of Burnsall out of the Corn tithe, also 13/4 to the Rector of Linton"
