On fass side in pain of Every Beast and Horse
one shilling and Every sheep sixpence - - - -
- one half to the - - - - the other to the use of
Town.

Also that Every Horse or Mare being two years old
or above go on Two Beast gates, and every Beast
on One Gate on Swinden, and if any found otherwise
the Default is for Every Horse mare or Gelding
Thirty six shillings for every Beast, Eighteen
shilling, and every sheep six shillings sixpence
One fourth part the Defaulters shall pay to the
finders and Bylawmen if the other to the use of
the town. Also that every fass lambs go on One
sheep Gate at Mid april till Midsummer and for
every Lamb that is found over which was lambd
before they went on the Default is 6d. One half
to the finder and the other to the use of the Town.

Also the Gaug one att Midsummer that has Lambs
just 7 on five sheep gates or 7 on a Beast Gate
if any be found over stint the Default is 1^s 4^d
each Lamb one fourth to the finders and Bylawmen
the other to the Town. Also if any Beast be found
over stint on Green the Default is for every Beast
10^d one fourth to the finder and Bylawmen the
other to the use of the Town.

Also that none shall put sheep on Beast Gate
on Swinden in pain of every Default 10^d to the use
of the Town.

Also that every one come to draw their stint on
both pastures when they have notice given by the
finders in the pain of every neglected 1^s to the
finders and Bylawmen

Also that every free person that has grazing on Green shall send for every 3 Gates & sufficient workmen or workwomen to dyke hills on Green when the finders shall give them notice and likewise to come to amend the fallways when they have notice given for each of their Defaults they shall pay one shilling half to the finders and the other to the Town

Also none shall neither graze nor digg plowes of peat or Turfs in the low fell (that is) betwixt Sharps gill and broad pot in pain of every best load Two Shilling to the use of the Town.

Also that none shall fell use no Salt any Turbary to go out of the Townships in pain that every Defaulter pay for every cart load two shilling six Pence and for every saddle full six pence One fourth to the informer the other to the Town

Also none shall mow neither Brackens Ricks on Green nor Swardin Before Michaelmas day in pain of every best load One Shilling to the use of the Town. Also none shall let their horses graze in the Town gate nor on the green in pain of every defaulter one shilling to the finders and the Bylawman.

Also that the fences and the Yeats hung by well and sufficiently made betwixt Harry Haldin and Francis Frankland betwixt third of May in pain of 2^s. 6^d for every Default.
