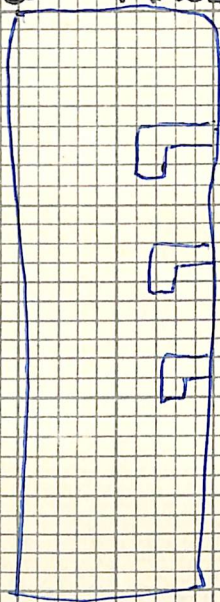

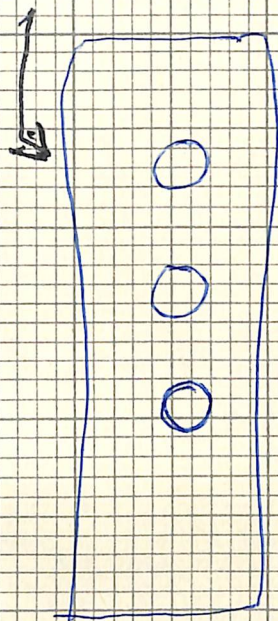
Harold Thompson, one of his drawings

He gave me a bit of kindling for my fire.

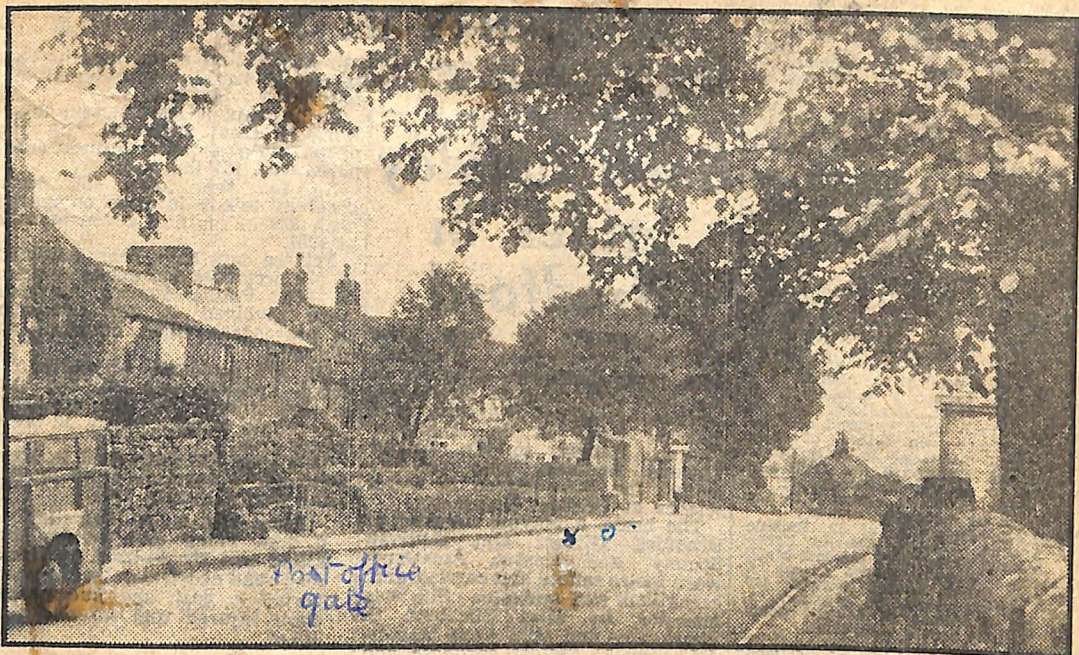
Sept 21 - 1978.

Addingham and Thornton. I had to help to side the place up when he gave it up in March. 16. 1962. I switched the Electric off and had the Meter Read, and told Mrs Taylor, Jack had the Cottage Rented for a Farm Man and Joe was that man till he was poor, and Jack didn't need a man now young John and him could manage. I told her there was the Telephone still in and the water to be cut off. No Body has lived in it since and now it is 1976.

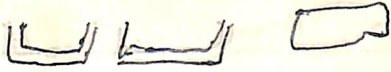
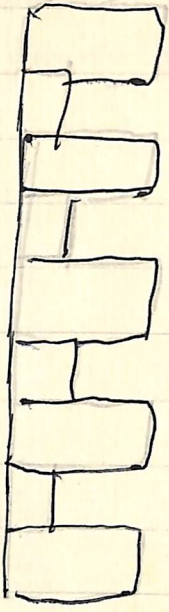

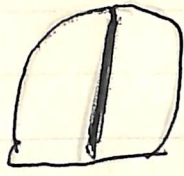
