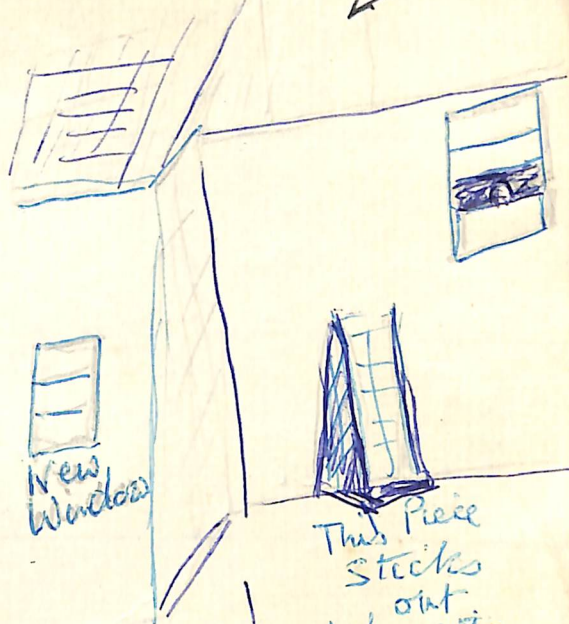

I thought well you should know, you are in that kind of Business.





Mr Hanson took this 1941

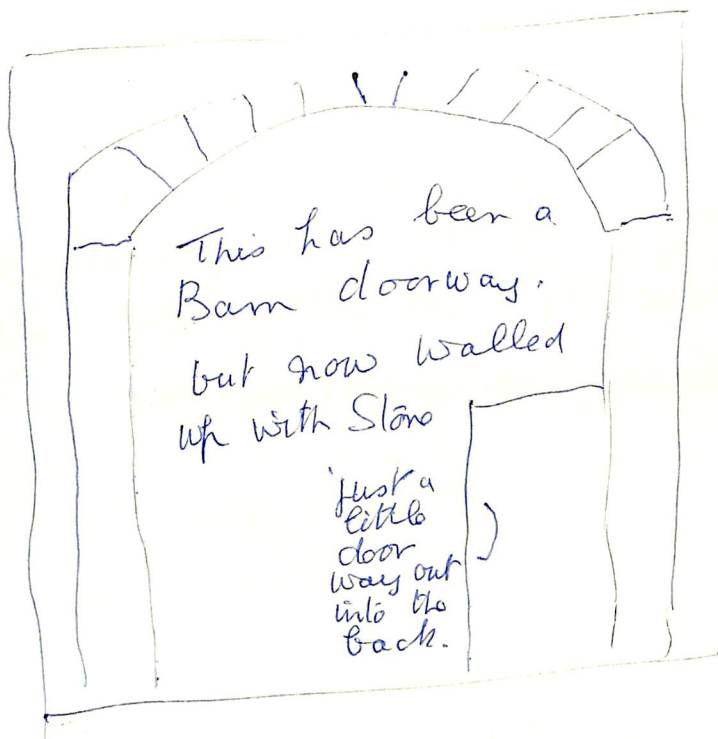
