never grazed it and it got to wall

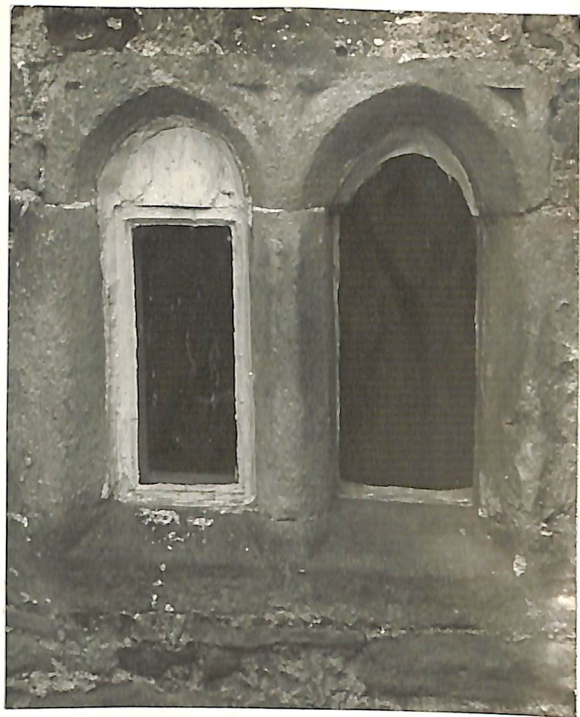
Top high 1974 with Docks. Joe

the fire.


